We are only able to accept non-perishable shelf stable foods, and small to medium sized containers are best. Food items past their "best buy" dates unfortunately must often be discarded.

You may be surprised to learn that most stock is not free. Much of it comes from the Regional Food Bank. However, some must be purchased from them and it is also subject to handling charges. Cash contributions usually allow dollars to go further because the Food Bank sells to us at reduced prices.
