Given the rapidly increasing rate of new COVID infections in our area, we have made the decision to return to online worship only using Zoom as of this Sunday, January 2nd. In-person worship will be suspended until the risk of infection has significantly dropped. There will just be one Morning Prayer service at 10 am each Sunday.

I know there have been audio issues with the Zoom broadcasts we have done from church, but we have made adjustments to the microphones, so hopefully it will improve. The church has been updated to accommodate wireless internet service as well.

Our plan is to install livestreaming capability over the winter which will vastly improve the visual and audio quality of the broadcast.

We did not plan for choral music this Sunday, so Tim will just play improvisations on the hymns.

I again would urge all of you to be vaccinated and to receive your booster shots. If you need help in finding vaccine sites, please contact the parish office.

I know this will be disappointing to many of us, but it seems absolutely the prudent decision to make. Thank you for your continued understanding and support. I wish you all a better New Year than 2021. That won't be difficult!
